





Analysis and deconstruction of gender stereotypes

Research on 6 partner's country on gender stereotypes among young, teacher and educators, analysing the cultural conditionings and families facing life trajectories and choices based on our biological sex. Stereotypes contained in the mass media and those spread on social media will be analysed through meetings and workshops with educators and young people.

Development of an educational package for educators

A manual for the early contrast to gender stereotypes, containing theoretical and practical references. An interactive training package, in English and in all languages of the partner's countries, consisting of operational tools for educators, available and usable through the project website. All the activities of the project will also be video-documented: educators and young people will be subject to building a storyboard of the project that will tell the central phases and the products of the activities carried out. The video storytelling is a central part of the web-doc and the training package.
